Notification

Sub. : Closure of Divisional Management Units (DMUs) under the West Bengal Forest and Biodiversity Conservation Society.

Whereas, the State Government, vide Serial Nos. 21,24, 25 and 28 of Annexure A to its Resolution No. 2623-For/G/6M-38/12 dated 21.12.2012, constituted the Buxa Tiger Reserve (East), Buxa Tiger Reserve (West), Wildlife-I(including Mahananda WLS) and Malda (including its FPC areas) as DMUs .

And whereas, the Japan International Co-operation Agency (JICA), vide the Mid-Term Review agreed to the closure of the above DMUs.


And whereas, the Governing Body of the West Bengal Forest and Biodiversity Conservation Society in its 9th meeting held on 16th June, 2016 approved the closure of Buxa Tiger Reserve (East) Buxa Tiger Reserve (West), Mahananda WLS portion of Wildlife-I and areas under the FPCs of the Malda Divisional Management Units (DMUs).

And Whereas, the State Government vide its Resolution No.2143-For/G/6M-38/12 dated 10.08.2016 has decided to close Buxa Tiger Reserve (East), Buxa Tiger Reserve (West), Mahananda WLS portion of Wildlife-I and areas under the FPCs of the Malda Divisional Management Units (DMUs).

Now, therefore, the West Bengal Forest and Biodiversity Conservation Society, hereby notifies that :

1. Buxa Tiger Reserve(East) and Buxa Tiger Reserve (West) DMUs declared vide Annexure-A to the State Government's Resolution No. 2623-For/G/6M-38/12 dated 21.12.2012 will cease to function as DMU from the date of issue of the latest resolution as mentioned above.
2. The Mahananda WLS portion of Wildlife-I DMU and the forest areas covered under the Forest Protection Committes of Malda DMU, declared vide Annexure-A to the State Government's Resolution No.; 2623-For/G/6M-38/12 dated 21.12.2012 will cease to be a part of the DMUs and hence the West Bengal Forest and Biodiversity Conservation Project from the date of issue of the latest resolution as mentioned above. The residual portion of Wildlife-I DMU and Malda DMU shall continue to be part of the respective DMUs.
3. Heads of Buxa Tiger Reserve (East) and Buxa Tiger Reserve (West) DMUs shall cease to function as Heads of DMUs. They shall close the Accounts of their respective DMUs and inform the same to the West Bengal Forest and Biodiversity Conservation Society.

4. The Field Management Units (FMUs), if any, created within the dissolved areas stated above shall also cease to function as FMU from the date of issue of the Government Resolution dated 10.08.2016 as mentioned above.


